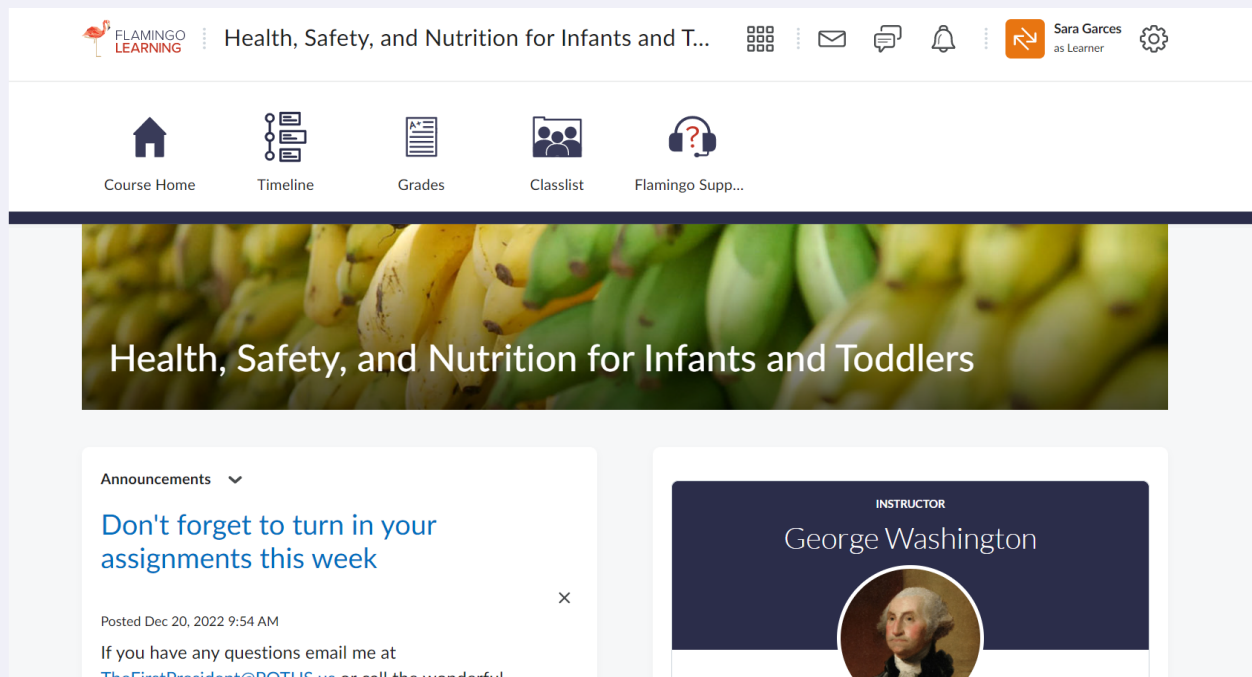
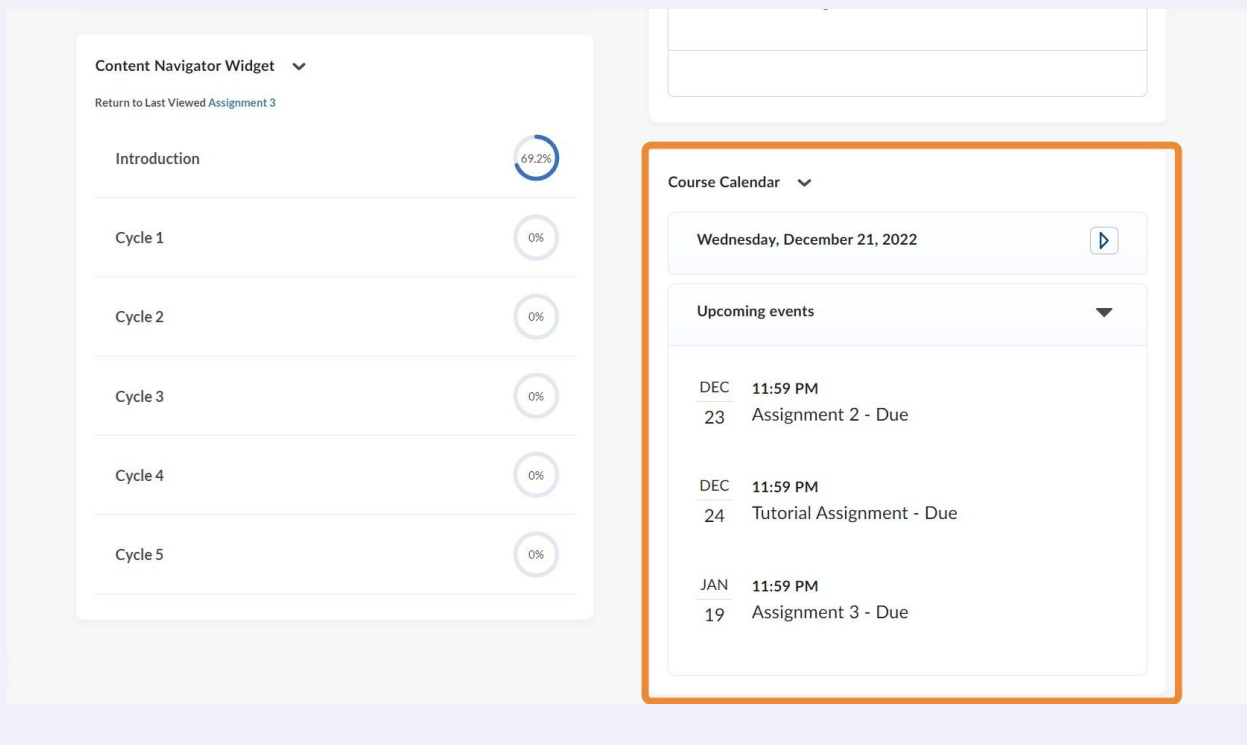


How to see Upcoming and Overdue Assignments

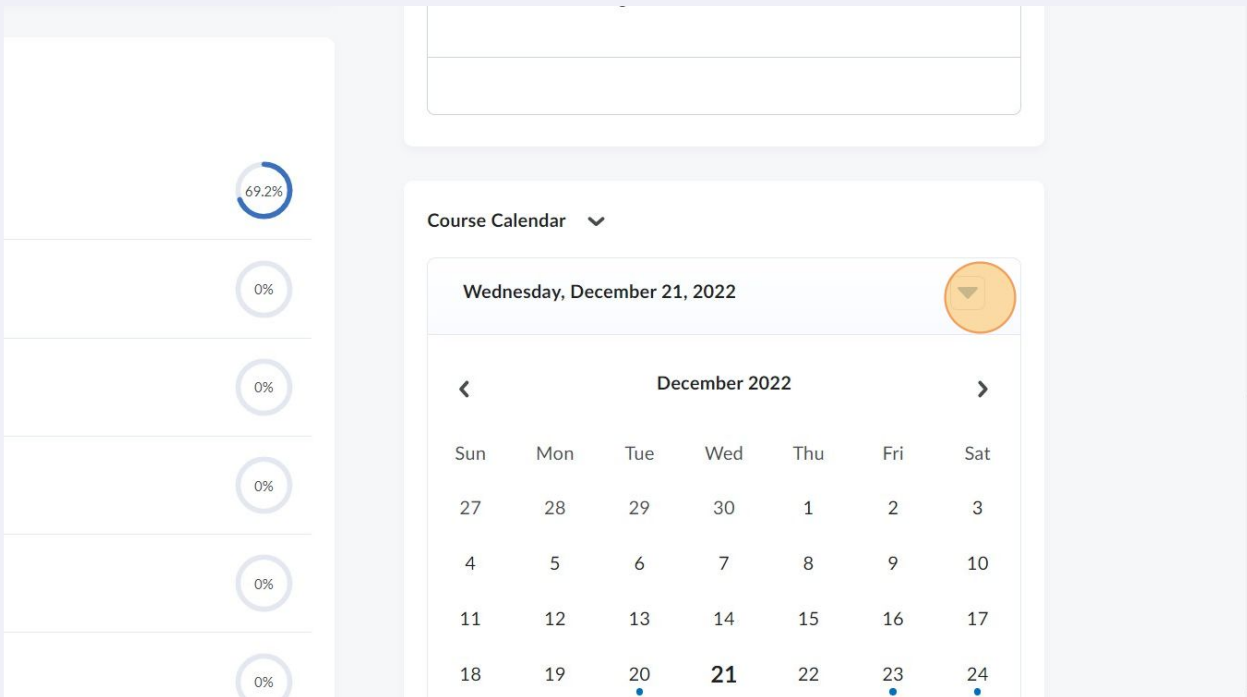
- 1 Navigate to your course home and scroll down.



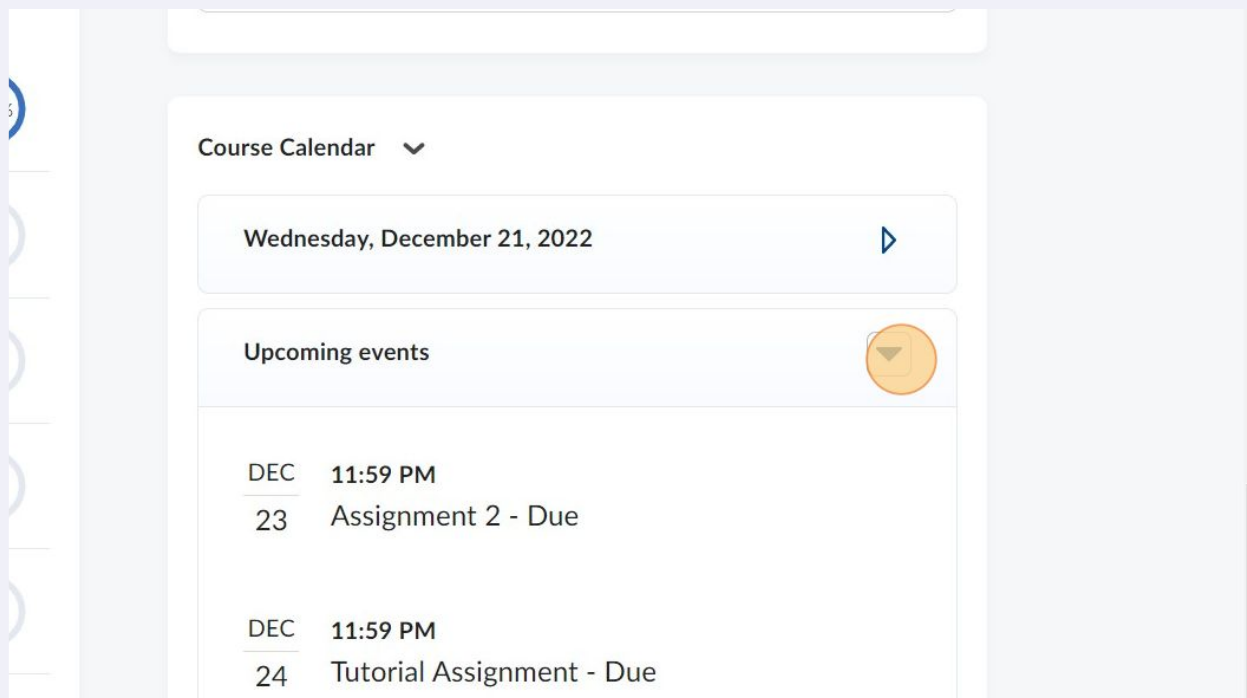
2 You will see a course calendar widget on the home page.



3 Click here to have a monthly view of which days you have assignments due (marked with a blue dot underneath)



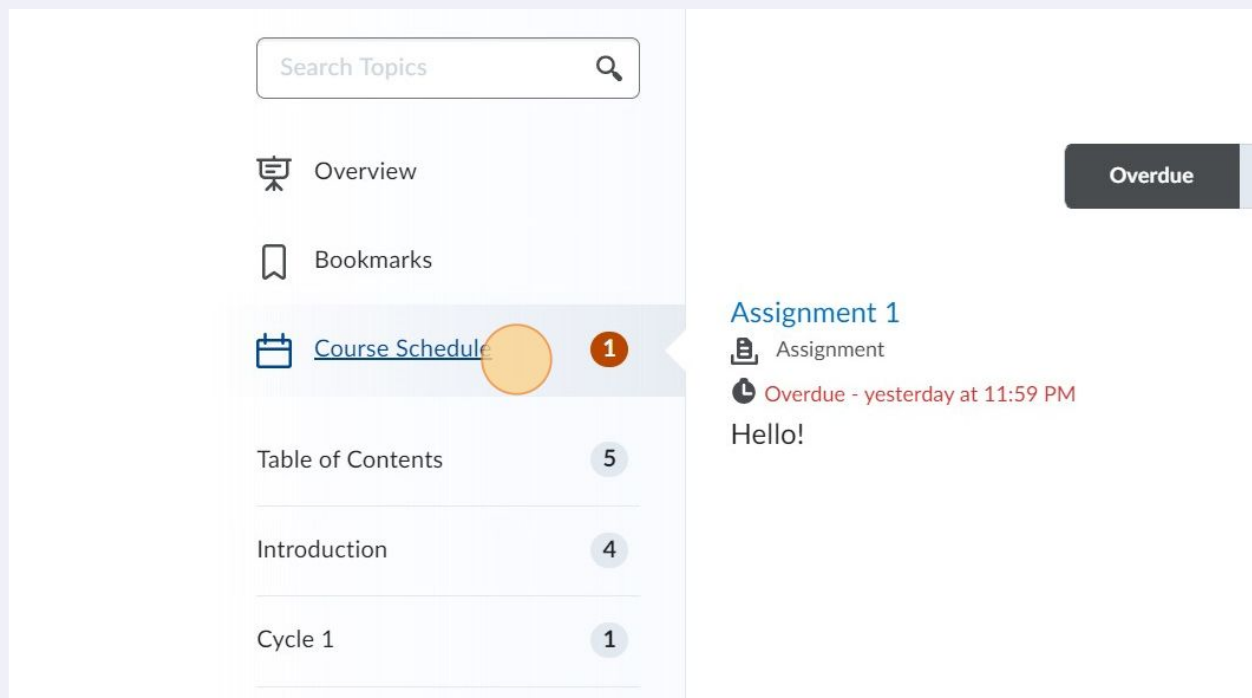
- 4 Click here to view all upcoming events and assignments for the course.



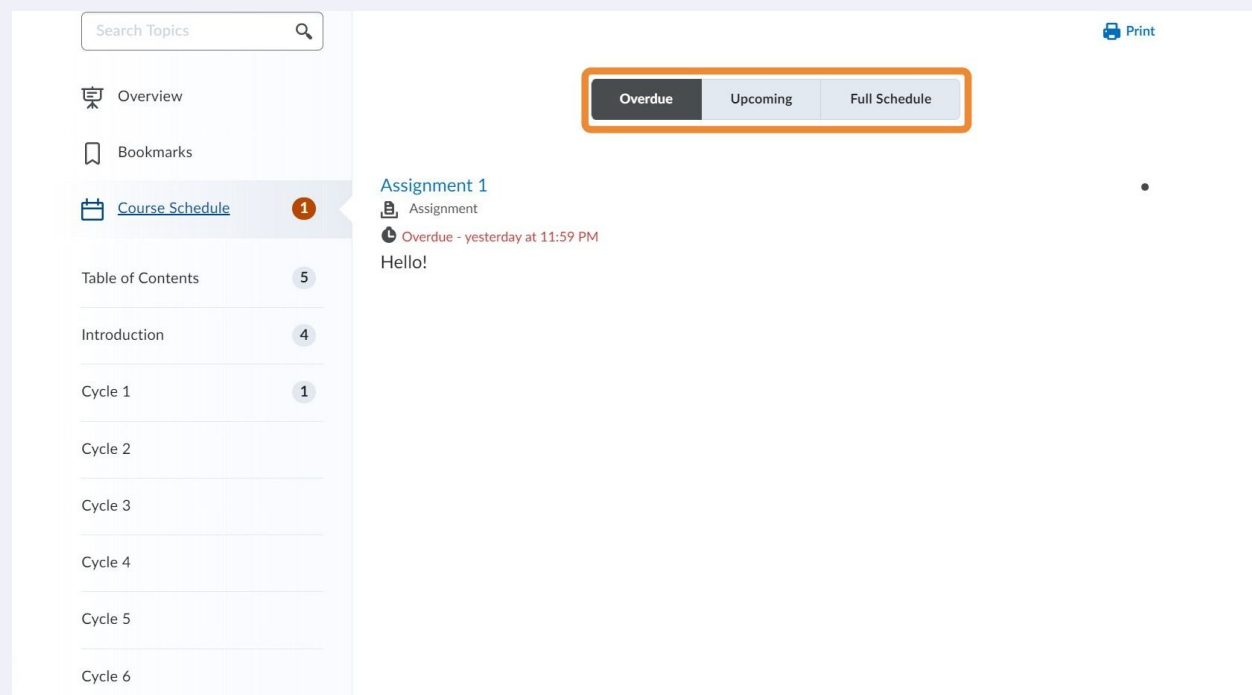
- 5 You can also access this information by clicking "Timeline" on the navigation bar at the top.
